Directions to The Cutter Farm

From North of Lowell Area

Rt. 495

- ◆ Take Rt. 495 South to exit 39, Rt. 133 (in Tewksbury). Go right off exit onto Rt. 133 towards Lowell.
- ◆ Follow several miles until the intersection with Rt. 110 and Rt. 38.
- ◆ Go right onto Rt. 38 (Nesmith St.). Pass hospital on your left, and enter rotary.
- ◆ Take 2nd exit off rotary onto Rt. 38.
- ◆ At 1st set of lights, stay straight onto VFW Highway (Rt. 38 goes right – Do Not stay on Rt. 38)
- ◆ Follow VFW Highway a few miles (The Merrimack River is on your left) to lights at Mammoth Road.
- ◆ Turn right onto Mammoth Rd. (Look for McDonald's on the corner.)
- ◆ Follow approx. 1 mile into Dracut. Look for Gumpus Rd. on your left
- ◆ Cutter Farm is the next property after Gumpus Rd., driveway is directly across from Donahue Rd.

Rt. 3

- ◆ Take Rt. 3 South exit 32, Rt. 4/Drum Hill.
- ◆ Follow traffic around to the left to Drum Hill Road (4th right). Follow thru a few sets of lights (past all the shopping).
- ◆ At the lights after the Ford dealer, bear to the left.
- ◆ Continue straight thru 2 more lights and over the Rourke Bridge.
- ◆ Once you cross the river, turn right onto Pawtucket Blvd. The river will be on your right.
- ◆ Follow for a few miles to lights at Mammoth Road. Look for McDonald's on your left.
- ◆ Turn left onto Mammoth Rd. Follow approx. 1 mile into Dracut. Look for Gumpus Rd. on your left
- ◆ Cutter Farm is the next property after Gumpus Rd., driveway is directly across from Donahue Rd.

From South of Lowell Area

Rt. 495

- ◆ Take Rt. 495 North to exit 33, Rt. 4 (in Chelmsford).

- ◆ Take left off exit onto Rt. 4 North.
- ◆ Follow approx. 1 mile. Turn right at lights onto Parkhurst Rd. Look for a small white church on corner.
- ◆ At fork, stay left. Go under highway, and at end of Parkhurst, turn right at lights onto Drum Hill Rd.
- ◆ At next set of lights, bear to the left.
- ◆ Continue straight thru 2 more lights and over the Rourke Bridge.
- ◆ Once you cross the river, turn right onto Pawtucket Blvd. The river will be on your right.
- ◆ Follow for a few miles to lights at Mammoth Road. Look for McDonald's on your left.
- ◆ Turn left onto Mammoth Rd. Follow approx. 1 mile into Dracut. Look for Gumpus Rd. on your left
- ◆ Cutter Farm is the next property after Gumpus Rd., driveway is directly across from Donahue Rd.

Rt. 3

- ◆ Take Rt. 3 North to exit 32, Rt. 4/Drum Hill.
- ◆ Take the first right onto Drum Hill Road. Follow thru a few sets of lights (past all the shopping).
- ◆ At the lights after the Ford dealer, bear to the left.
- ◆ Continue straight thru 2 more lights and over the Rourke Bridge.
- ◆ Once you cross the river, turn right onto Pawtucket Blvd. The river will be on your right.
- ◆ Follow for a few miles to lights at Mammoth Road. Look for McDonald's on your left.
- ◆ Turn left onto Mammoth Rd. Follow approx. 1 mile into Dracut. Look for Gumpus Rd. on your left
- ◆ Cutter Farm is the next property after Gumpus Rd., driveway is directly across from Donahue Rd.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. If weather is so severe that riding would be dangerous, the competition will be cancelled and entry fees, less \$15, will be refunded.
2. This is not a sanctioned competition, but every class will be judged as nearly as possible in accordance with USEA rules. Show Management will determine variation from those rules.
3. Negative Coggins test dated May 16, 2007 or later is required for all entries. Entries received without a negative Coggins will not be processed.
4. Entry forms must be completed in their entirety and signed by the rider or a legal guardian if under 18 years of age.
5. Entries received without payment will not be processed. **Make checks payable to The Cutter Farm.**
6. Entries postmarked prior to the opening date or after the closing date will not be accepted.
7. **Refunds and/or changes** are subject to a \$15 office fee. No refunds after the closing date without a signed veterinary/physician's certificate.
8. All returned checks will be charged a \$30.00 fee.
9. **SEI approved helmets with harness fastened are required at all times while mounted for the 2-Phase competition and for all competitors under the age of 18.**
10. Horses will remain in control and at the walk on the grounds outside the show rings or warm-up areas. No horses allowed in restricted areas.
11. There shall be no working of horses outside the designated show rings or warm-up areas. Schooling over the fences on the jump course is prohibited and will result in disqualification.
12. For the safety of all, show management reserves the right to excuse any horse/rider for unwarranted misbehavior - including uncontrolled behavior - and/or unsoundness.
13. **Dressage times** will be posted on our website www.cutterfarm.com and emailed by Thursday, May 15th.
14. Commanded tests will not be eligible for awards and/or ribbons in the 2-Phase division.
15. All jumping will take place in a sand ring over standard show jumping type fences.
16. Each horse/rider combination may only compete in one 2-phase division.
17. You may ride as many dressage tests as you like.
18. All dressage tests will be in a small arena.
19. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide divisions when deemed necessary.
20. **Ribbons/Awards:** 1st Place prizes and ribbons to 8th place will be awarded in each class.
21. **Food & water** will be available on site.
22. **No dogs** allowed on farm property.
