Hello,

Thank you for your interest in taking riding lessons at The Cutter Farm. I require all new students to take an initial private evaluation lesson which is one hour long. In the first half-hour, the student will learn how to groom the horse, and put the equipment on as well as how to handle the horse. The second halfhour is in the saddle, where I will evaluate the student's strengths and weaknesses on the horse so that I can suggest the best lesson program.

The prices for the lessons when paid weekly are as follows:

1st Evaluation	\$90
Private Hour	\$85
Private Half Hour	\$70
Semi-Private Hour (2 students)	\$75

We do not take credit cards. Please pay with a check or cash. Lesson days are Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

All cancellations require 24-HOUR NOTICE, no shows and same day cancellations pay full price. I am VERY strict about this policy.

For the safety of students, during the lesson you will need to wear appropriate clothing. This includes PANTS ONLY, a flat shoe with a small 1" heel, and a helmet. Helmets are available at the farm for students if needed. Students with long hair MUST have it pulled back in a low ponytail to keep it out of their face.

To provide students with a safe, positive experience, I need their undivided attention. Parents and siblings can be distracting. **Do not stand ringside**. **Children must be quiet and seated** so as not to startle the horses. Please leave other animals at home. I also ask that you do not take flash photos without permission.
